

**THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(CHILTERN DISTRICT) (CONSOLIDATION)**  
**(AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) ORDER, 201**

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order is to amend existing restrictions within Chiltern as specified in the schedule below.

A copy of the Order and Plans showing the length of road affected, together with a copy of the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at County Hall, Aylesbury and during normal opening hours at Amersham Library, Chiltern Avenue, Amersham, Chesham Library, Elgiva Lane, Chesham, Gerrards Cross Library, 38 Station Road, Gerrards Cross and Great Missenden Library, High Street, Great Missenden.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.

**SCHEDULE**

1. To introduce waiting limited to two hours with no return within two hours between 8am and 6 pm Monday to Friday in the presently unrestricted length of Orchard Lane, Amersham.
2. To remove a section of no waiting 10am to 11am and 2pm to 4pm Monday to Friday in Lincoln Park, Amersham.
3. To introduce no waiting at any time at the southern entrance of Chiltern Road and Amersham Road, along Amersham Road at its junctions with Chiltern Road (northern entrance) and Clifton Road, Chesham Bois.
4. To create parking for disabled persons' vehicles in sections of Elm Tree Hill and Forelands Way, Chesham, and High Street, Prestwood.
5. To introduce a combination of no waiting at any time, no waiting 11am to 12 noon and no waiting 2pm to 3pm Monday to Friday in Milton Avenue, Orchehill Avenue, and Bull Lane, Gerrards Cross.
6. To amend the existing limited waiting, one hour no return within one hour 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday, in Link Road, High Street and Station Approach, Great Missenden, to waiting limited to one hour no return within one hour between 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.
7. To introduce no waiting at any time at the junction of Springfields and Lexham Gardens, Amersham.
