COUNCIL CONSULTATION

This resolution is from the minutes of Full Council on
Monday 8th July 2019.

It was resolved to seek the approval of the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government to apply for a loan from the Public Works Loan Board of £100,000 for up to 10 years in order to carry out stabilisation works on the wall at the Platt Cemetery, Old Amersham.

The Town Council is responsible for maintenance of the Cemetery and a section of the 150 year old brick and flint wall has had to be removed as the foundations were found to be weakened and in need of reinforcement.

Given the topography of the ground adjacent to the wall, the Town Council has commissioned a series of investigations and a specialist contractor has been appointed to produce a sensitive design solution to strengthen the wall and undertake complex technical groundworks, including underpinning.

The Annual Loan repayments will be approximately £10,712 based on a 1.33% interest rate. It is not intended to increase the Council Tax precept for the purpose of the loan repayments as an allowance has been made in the Council's capital expenditure budget for this purpose.
